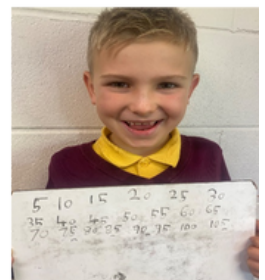
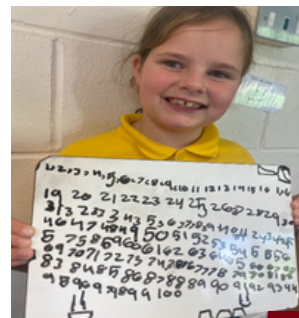
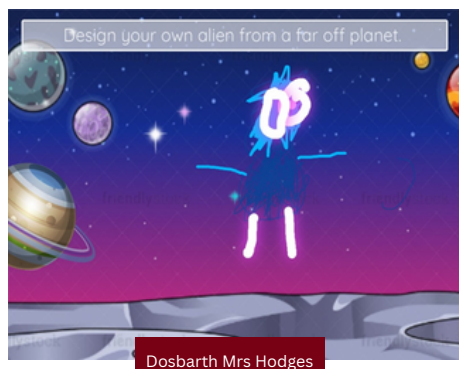
We have had a very busy start to the school year with the children taking part in many engaging activities and exciting events.

Some of the other activities the children have been involved in recently:

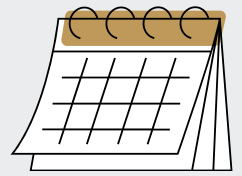
