1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Non completion of work • Distracting behaviour 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Verbal warning • Proximity praise • Reminders of acceptable behaviour • Second verbal warning = orange or yellow pot 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Class based • Staff • Pupil
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unacceptable behaviour which does not conform to school rules 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Red pot (KS2) • Short playtime detention (no more than age plus 2 minutes up to a maximum of 10 minutes) • Restorative justice • Recorded on Behaviour Log 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents / carers if appropriate • Class staff • Pupil
3	<p>Unacceptable behaviour on the yard or in class, which disrupts teaching and learning e.g.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Receiving three short detentions within a half term period • Deliberate and persistent calling out in class 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Whole play time detention • Restorative justice • Parents informed • Incident recorded on My Concern 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents / carers • Class staff • Pupil

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not staying on task • Leaving class without permission • Remaining in the building at playtimes without permission • Failure to attend short detention • Answering back • Wilful disobedience • Name calling 		
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Receiving two full playtime detentions within half a term • Failure to attend full playtime detention • Persistent disruptive behaviour • Physical or verbal abuse towards others • Persistent bullying • Inappropriate use of equipment / digital media 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Incident recorded on My Concern • Parents informed • Lunchtime detention or internal exclusion if appropriate • Restorative justice • Restricted access to the yard • Fixed term exclusion if appropriate • Outside agency support sought if appropriate eg, CART referral/Early Help 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents / carers • LEA • HEADTEACHER • Pupil
5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Abusive language directed at staff • Serious actual or threatened violence against another pupil, or member of staff • Sexual abuse or assault • Supplying an illegal drug • Carrying an offensive weapon 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Incident recorded on MyConcern • Parents and LEA informed • Fixed term or permanent exclusion as appropriate • Outside agency support sought eg Early Help, CART, Youth Justice • If a crime has been committed the Police may be contacted 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents / carers • LEA • Class staff • HEADTEACHER • Pupil
